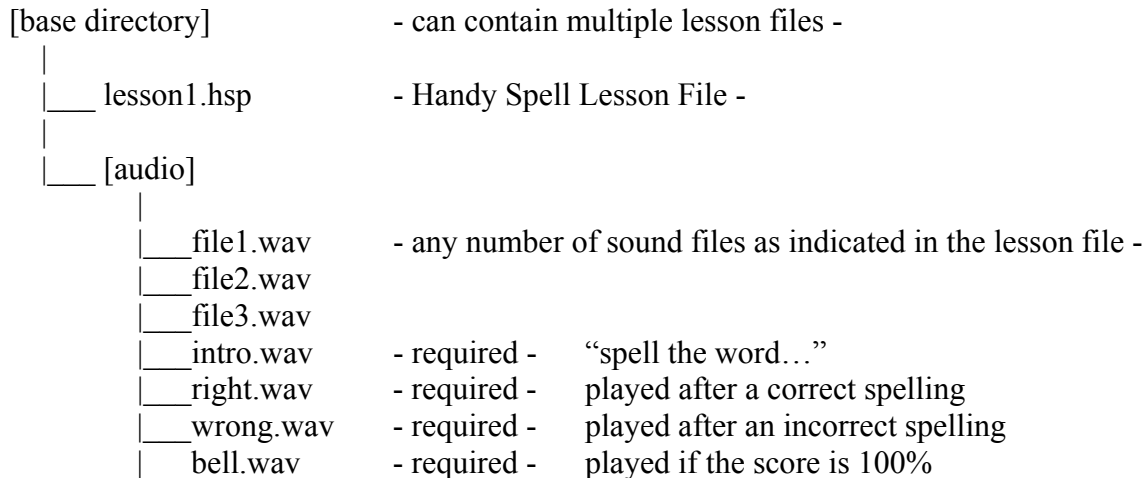


Lesson Construction for Handy Spell

Handy Spell lesson files and associated audio should be organized in the following fashion. The base directory can be any name that represents the lessons contained within.



The lesson files should follow this simple xml pattern.

```
<lesson>
  <item>hike|hike.wav</item>
  <item>awoke|awoke.wav</item>
  <item>twice|twice.wav</item>
  <item>closed|closed.wav</item>
</lesson>
```

In the example `<item>hike|hike.wav</item>` -- the text¹ on the left of the vertical line i.e. ‘hike’ is the word to spell... the text on the right of the vertical line i.e. ‘hike.wav’ is the audio file associated with the word.

It is not necessary for both words to be spelled similarly. Remember: You must follow these guidelines or Handy Spell will not operate properly!
